

ORDINANCE NO. 08-05 AC CMS (FAILED)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE NO. 07-69 AC CMS WHICH APPROVED THE FORM AND AUTHORIZED THE EXECUTION OF A POWER SALES CONTRACT WITH AMERICAN MUNICIPAL POWER, INC., (AMP-OHIO) TO INCREASE THE PARTICIPATION OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN IN THE AMERICAN MUNICIPAL POWER GENERATING STATION PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Section 3 of Ordinance No. 07-69 AC CMS, passed by Oberlin City Council on October 1st, 2007, which, among other things, provided for the City of Oberlin to receive "up to a nominal amount of 9,000 kilowatts" as its maximum Power Sales Contract Resources (PSCR) Share from the proposed American Municipal Power Generating Station, is hereby amended to increase the City of Oberlin's maximum requested PSCR Share to 10,000 kilowatts, and the City Manager is hereby directed to transmit a certified copy of this Ordinance to AMP-Ohio at the earliest possible date in order to ensure its receipt by AMP- Ohio prior to March 1, 2008.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit:

"to ensure that the City of Oberlin has timely taken action to increase it's participation in the proposed American Municipal Power Generating Station project",

and shall take effect immediately upon passage
