

ORDINANCE NO. 08-17 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF CEDAR BAY CONSTRUCTION, INC., OF HURON, OHIO, FOR "CONTRACT A – COMPLETE PLANT" FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO THE CITY OF OBERLIN RAW WATER PUMP STATION AND THE WATER TREATMENT PLANT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Cedar Bay Construction, Inc. of Huron, Ohio, being the lowest and best bid submitted for improvements to the City of Oberlin raw water pump station and Water Treatment Plant, including General Trades, Electrical, Plumbing and HVAC (collectively known as Contract "A"), is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract in accordance with the bid in an amount not to exceed \$4,217,000.

SECTION 2. That this contract award is subject to and contingent upon the City's procurement of an anticipated Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, Water Supply Revolving Loan Account loan from the Ohio Water Development Authority within a reasonable time, and upon terms acceptable to the City.


SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit:

*"to accept a bid within the time limitations provided by law"
and shall take effect immediately upon passage.*
