

ORDINANCE NO. 08-54 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 97-107 AC CMS, AS AMENDED, THAT ESTABLISHED A POLICY ON EXPENDITURES OF PUBLIC FUNDS FOR EMPLOYEE AND RESIDENT APPRECIATION AND EVENTS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Sections 1 and 2 of Ordinance 97-107 AC CMS, as amended by Ordinance 03-106, are hereby amended to read as follows:

“SECTION 1. That the amounts available for the City of Oberlin employee recognition breakfast, City picnic, City holiday gathering, and other City-sponsored special events and meetings, including but not limited to, ground breaking ceremonies, Public Power Week, meals for City business and Council meetings (including Council retreats), board and commission appreciation events, are subject to annual appropriations. In addition, Council Appointees are authorized to establish uniform guidelines for expenditures for employee and business-related expenditures, including, but not limited to, retirement events, bereavement, and refreshments for City hosted business meetings, that are reasonable and prudent and subject to annual appropriations.

SECTION 2. That funds are to be used for event-related expenses, such as food, beverage, gifts, and promotional item. The City Manager and Finance Director must approve all expenditures. No alcoholic beverages shall be purchased with these monies.”


SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.


