

ORDINANCE NO. 08-79 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING COMPENSATION FOR AN ASSISTANT PROBATION OFFICER FOR THE OBERLIN MUNICIPAL COURT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That compensation for the position of Assistant Probation Officer, effective November 3, 2008, or as soon thereafter as the Judge of the Oberlin Municipal Court determines, is hereby authorized in an amount not to exceed \$15.00 per hour.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit:

“to ensure that the Oberlin Municipal Court has the necessary probation staff in its Community Control Department at the earliest possible date”,

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
