

ORDINANCE NO. 08-81 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONTRACT WITH RMH CONCRETE AND FOUNDATIONS, INC. OF COLLINS, OHIO, FOR THE ORCHARD STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 08-41 City Council awarded a contract to RMH Concrete and Foundations, Inc. of Collins, Ohio for the Orchard Street Improvement Project in the amount of \$192,424,40; and

WHEREAS, during the course of construction it has been determined that it is necessary to make additional improvements to the storm sewer system and improvements not previously foreseen to the sanitary sewer system and, as a result of said additional work, the contract amount needs to be increased by \$ 33,162. 97.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the contract between the City of Oberlin and RMH Concrete and Foundations, Inc., as approved by Ordinance No. 08-41 AC CMS, for the Orchard Street Improvement Project in the City of Oberlin, is hereby amended to authorize the payment of an additional \$33,162.97 to RMH Concrete and Foundations, Inc. for additional necessary work discovered during construction, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute an amendment to said contract authorizing said payment.


SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit:

"to ensure the proper functioning of the storm sewer and sanitary sewer systems at the earliest possible date", and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
