

ORDINANCE NO. 09-24 AC CMS

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF A.J. RILEY INC., OF NORWALK, OHIO,
FOR PAVING AND DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS AT THE CITY OF OBERLIN
RECREATION COMPLEX PARKING LOT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of A.J. Riley Inc., of Norwalk, Ohio, for paving and drainage improvements at the Recreation Complex Parking Lot for the City of Oberlin, Ohio, being the lowest and best bid submitted, is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract accordingly, said bid being in an amount not to exceed \$234,810.00.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That the ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit:


"to accept a bid within the time limitations provided by law", and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
