

ORDINANCE NO. 09-25 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE NEIGHBORHOOD HOUSE ASSOCIATION OF LORAIN COUNTY, INC. AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin has previously supported senior citizens activities within the City of Oberlin; and

WHEREAS, Neighborhood House Association of Lorain County, Inc., is a non-profit corporation which has agreed to provide to the residents of the City those senior citizen activities and services previously supported by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to authorize the City Manager to enter into a contract with Neighborhood House Association of Lorain County, Inc., under the terms of which Neighborhood House Association of Lorain County, Inc., will operate a senior citizens program and furnish those services to the citizens of the City, and in return for which the City shall provide financial assistance to Neighborhood House Association of Lorain County, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager be, and hereby is, authorized to enter into a contract with Neighborhood House Association of Lorain County, Inc., whereby the City will provide financial assistance to Neighborhood House Association of Lorain County, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$42,500, as appropriated in Ordinance No. 08-90 AC CMS, said monies only to be used for operating purposes of Oberlin Seniors and to provide to the residents of Oberlin those services as set forth in the agreement attached hereto as "**Exhibit A**" and incorporated herein by reference.


SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit:


*"to timely provide funds for important contracted services",
