#### ORDINANCE 09-49 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING BURGESS & NIPLE, INC. TO PERFORM ADDITIONAL ENGINEERING WORK RELATED TO THE ONGOING IMPROVEMENTS AT THE CITY OF OBERLIN RAW WATER PUMP STATION AND AT THE WATER TREATMENT PLANT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manger is hereby authorized and directed to execute the attached agreement with Burgess & Niple, Inc. for additional engineering work related to the ongoing improvements at the City of Oberlin Raw Water Pump Station and at the Water Treatment Plant in an amount not to exceed \$29,250.00.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit:

"to authorize additional necessary engineering work as soon as possible relating to the ongoing improvements at the City of Oberlin Raw Water Pump Station and at the Water Treatment Plant" and shall take effect immediately upon passage.

# SUPPLEMENTAL A GREEMENT NO. 4 BETWEEN CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO AND

## BURGESS & NIPLE, INC. FOR ENGINEERING AND ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES

This Supplemental AGREEMENT shall be attached to and become a part of the Master AGREEMENT dated July 1, 2002.

#### SECTION III - SCOPE OF SERVICES

#### C. DESIGN IMPROVEMENTS

#### C-4 Services During Construction

Supplemental Agreement No. 3 signed 6/6/06 by the City Manager included a fee of \$158,400 for Services During Construction. The fee of \$158,400 was based on a 12-month construction schedule. At design completion and based on contractor requests during the bidding period, B&N and the City agreed that the construction schedule should be extended to a total of 15 months. Currently the General Contractor is requesting a contract extension of an additional 6 weeks so that the total construction duration will be 16 ½ months.

Some of B&N construction services will require additional time and expense due to the 4 ½-month construction schedule extension. The following services will require additional time:

- Review and recommend payment or nonpayment of requests for progress payment by the Contractor.
- 2. Prepare additional detailed meeting minutes.
- 3. Schedule and conduct biweekly meetings at the site to review the work. Conduct additional site visits as necessary.
- 4. Respond to requests for information regarding the application of the Contract Documents.
- 5. Meetings with the OWNER as required. Provide additional project management.

Nothing in this AGREEMENT, with respect to furnishing of Construction Administration, Services shall be construed to make B&N responsible for, nor to have control of, construction means, methods, techniques, sequences, procedures or for safety precautions and programs in connection with the work, nor to make B&N responsible for the contractor's failure to carry out the work in accordance with the Contract Documents, nor to confer responsibility upon B&N for any acts or omissions of the Contractor, subcontractors, or others performing or inspecting the work.

### SECTION IV - FEE FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

B&N will provide these services on the basis of the attached hourly fee schedule, plus reimbursable expenses for a not-to-exceed fee of \$29,250, unless approved in writing by the OWNER. This will increase the Services During Construction fee from \$158,400 as shown in Supplemental Agreement No. 3 to \$187,650.
