ORDINANCE NO. 09-61 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE IN COMPENSATION FOR THE CITY CLERK/CLERK OF OBERLIN CITY COUNCIL AND AMENDING ORDINANCE 07-51 AC CMS, AS AMENDED, APPOINTING THE CITY CLERK/CLERK OF OBERLIN CITY COUNCIL AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the salary of the City Clerk/Clerk of Oberlin City Council is hereby increased to \$44,346 annually, effective May 28, 2009, plus those benefits provided in Ordinance No. 07-51 AC CMS, as amended.

SECTION 2. That Subsection 2. of Section 1 of Ordinance 07-51 AC CMS, as amended, passed May 21, 2007, is hereby amended to read as follows:

2. All City of Oberlin full-time non-collective bargaining employee benefits, including, but not limited to, OPERS retirement contributions, medical insurance coverage, and vacation and sick leave; and \$150,000 of life insurance.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit:

"to provide for a merit increase for the City Clerk/Clerk of Council to coincide with her anniversary date," and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
