

**ORDINANCE NO. 09-74 AC CMS**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE EDGE GROUP, INC. OF COLUMBUS, OHIO FOR PROFESSIONAL PLANNING SERVICES FOR THE PREPARATION OF A PARKS, RECREATION AND SCHOOL ATHLETIC FACILITIES STRATEGIC PLAN AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

Whereas, the City of Oberlin and the Oberlin City School District have determined that it is in the best interest of the Oberlin community for the City and the School District to conduct a joint strategic planning process to assess the parks, recreation and school athletic facilities and programs; and

Whereas, by proceeding with a joint study both the Oberlin Schools and the City of Oberlin will benefit from a cost savings for the work to be performed and will receive the most comprehensive and thorough assessment, to the betterment of both entities.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected hereto concurring.

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with The EDGE Group, Inc. of Columbus, Ohio for professional planning services for the preparation of a Parks, Recreation and School Athletic Facilities Strategic Plan for the City of Oberlin and the Oberlin City School District in an amount not to exceed \$45,000. A copy of the proposed contract is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. The City of Oberlin shall be responsible to pay a maximum amount of \$25,500 and the Oberlin City School District shall be responsible to pay a maximum amount of \$19,500 as defined in the proposed contract.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit:

“to proceed with the planning and design for the replacement structure in a timely manner”, and shall take effect immediately upon passage.


