ORDINANCE NO. 10-21 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF HARRISON FORD, INC., OF WELLINGTON, OHIO, FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE 2010 FORD FUSION HYBRID VEHICLE FOR THE OBERLIN POLICE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Harrison Ford Inc. of Wellington, Ohio, for the purchase of one 2010 Ford Fusion Hybrid vehicle for the Oberlin Police Department, being the lowest and best bid submitted, is hereby accepted, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract in accordance with said bid, in an amount not to exceed \$26,500.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit:

"to authorize the purchase of one police vehicle as soon as possible to ensure the efficient operation of the police department," and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
