

## City of Oberlin, Ohio

### ORDINANCE No. 11-54 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ASSESSING THE COST FOR ABATING NUISANCE CAUSED BY NON-COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 110.3 OF THE PROPERTY MAINTENANCE CODE OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN AND SECTION 715.261 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That this Council finds that the City of Oberlin Building Official has abated nuisance conditions at the following properties, and reported the cost of such abatement in the manner provided by law, as follows:

SECTION 2. That the amounts shown above are hereby assessed upon the properties indicated by permanent parcel number and such assessments shall be certified for collection upon the 2011 tax duplicate in the same manner as general taxes.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.



and shall take effect immediately upon passage.


