ORDINANCE No. 11- 62 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO DONATE AND DEDICATE PERPETUAL EASEMENTS FOR HIGHWAY PURPOSES WITHOUT LIMITATION OF EXISTING ACCESS RIGHTS IN THE NAME AND FOR THE USE OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO FOR THE PARK STREET BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT IN THE CITY OF OBERLIN AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 10-04AC CMS, the City of Oberlin agreed to cooperate with the Ohio Department of Transportation for the replacement of the Park Street Bridge in the City of Oberlin; and

WHEREAS, the replacement of the Park Street Bridge in the City of Oberlin is further identified by the Ohio Department of Transportation by the project name LOR Park Street Bridge and the PID No. 83140; and

WHEREAS, in order to complete this project it is necessary for the City to dedicate perpetual easements for highway purposes without limitation of existing access rights in the name and for the use of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to donate and dedicate the perpetual easements attached hereto as Exhibit A, for highway purposes without limitation of existing access rights in the name and for the use of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio for the Park Street Bridge Replacement Project.


SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit:

“to promote the public health and safety by expediting the replacement of the Park Street Bridge”, and shall take effect immediately upon passage.


