ORDINANCE No. 11-66 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE IN COMPENSATION FOR THE FINANCE DIRECTOR AND AMENDING ORDINANCE 00-99 AC CMS, AS AMENDED, APPOINTING A FINANCE DIRECTOR FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the salary of the Finance Director is hereby increased to \$94,140 annually, effective September 25, 2011, plus those benefits provided in Ordinance No. 00-99 AC CMS, as amended.

SECTION 2. That the Finance Director is authorized to serve in various capacities of professional organizations/consortiums, boards, committees, etc., and to accept any stipends, per diems and/or other payments provided by said organizations for such service.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit:

“to implement a merit increase for the Finance Director to coincide with his anniversary date at the earliest date possible,”

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
