ORDINANCE No. 12-11 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH BURGESS & NIPLE, INC. TO PERFORM ADDITIONAL ENGINEERING WORK RELATED TO THE IMPROVEMENTS TO THE HEADWORKS AT THE CITY OF OBERLIN WATER ENVIRONMENT PROTECTION FACILITY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 11-38 AC CMS Oberlin City Council authorized a contract with Burgess & Niple, Inc. of Akron, Ohio, for professional engineering design services for improvements to the headworks at the City of Oberlin Water Environment Protection Facility in the amount of \$28,900.00; and

WHEREAS, the additional unforeseen work necessary to properly complete the design of the project and to bid the project necessitates an increase of \$3,900.00 in the contract amount.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute the attached amendment to the agreement with Burgess & Niple, Inc. for additional professional engineering services related to the improvements to the headworks at the City of Oberlin Water Environment Protection Facility in an amount not to exceed \$3,900.00.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit:

"to authorize additional necessary engineering work as soon as possible relating to the design of the proposed improvements at the headworks at the City of Oberlin Water Environment Protection Facility" and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
