AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, AND THE INTERNATIONAL BROTHERHOOD OF ELECTRICAL WORKERS (IBEW) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the attached Agreement between the City of Oberlin and the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW), on behalf of certain municipal employees, is hereby approved and ratified, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute same on behalf of the City.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio or to provide for the usual daily operations of a municipal department, to wit:

"to ratify an agreed-upon collective bargaining agreement as soon as possible in order to ensure the efficient operation of the City", and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
