ORDINANCE No.12-63 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 07-51 AC CMS, AS AMENDED, APPOINTING THE CITY CLERK/CLERK OF OBERLIN CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, TO ADJUST CERTAIN BENEFITS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That subsection "2." of Section 1. of Ordinance 07-51 AC CMS, as amended, passed May 21, 2007, is hereby amended to read as follows, effective May 28, 2012:

2. All City of Oberlin full-time employee benefits, including, but not limited to, OPERS retirement contributions, medical insurance coverage, and vacation and sick leave; and \$150,000 of life insurance; OPERS (The Employer share and an additional 2% salary OPERS allowance shall be paid to the employee), the City's additional salary OPERS allowance shall be reviewed on the five-year anniversary, and each subsequent five-year anniversary, at which time additional 1% increases will be considered.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit:

"to implement a change in OPERS salary allowance for the City Clerk/Clerk of Oberlin City Council to coincide with her anniversary date at the earliest date possible," and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
