ORDINANCE No.13-25 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION FOR THE CLERK OF COUNCIL FOR SPECIAL PROJECTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the Clerk of Council shall receive \$45 per hour for additional projects as approved by Motion of Oberlin City Council.


SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit:

“in order for the Clerk to be timely compensated for extra duties and special projects authorized by Oberlin City Council,” and shall take effect immediately upon passage.”
