## ORDINANCE No. 13-49 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT OHIO HISTORY FUND GRANT PROGRAM FUNDING FROM THE OHIO HISTORICAL SOCIETY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin desires to participate in the Ohio Historical Society's 2013 Ohio History Fund Grant Program in order to receive financial assistance for the Oberlin Underground Railroad Center Phase II Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin has the authority to apply for financial assistance, to enter into a contract with the Ohio Historical Society, and to administer funds received through the Ohio History Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

- SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to apply for 2013 Ohio History Fund Grant Program funds to the Ohio Historical Society in the amount of \$20,000 for the Oberlin Underground Railroad Center Phase II Improvement Project.
- SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to accept a grant award from the Ohio Historical Society for the Oberlin Underground Railroad Center Phase II Improvement Project.
- SECTION 3. That participation in the Ohio History Fund Grant Program will require compliance with State guidelines and assurances.
- SECTION 4. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to commit to the local share of funding as identified in the grant application.
- SECTION 5. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 6. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operations of a municipal department, to wit: in order to allow for the timely application for said Ohio History Fund Grant Program grant funding in accordance with all applicable procedures and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
