ORDINANCE No. 13-73 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A ONE-TIME BONUS TO THE OBERLIN CLERK OF COUNCIL FOR ACHIEVING HER MASTER MUNICIPAL CLERK DESIGNATION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 10-51 AC CMS Oberlin City Council committed to providing the Clerk of Oberlin City Council a bonus when she achieved the designation of Master Municipal Clerk.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Oberlin City Council hereby authorizes a one-time bonus in an amount of \$3,000 to be paid to the Oberlin City Council Clerk for achieving her Master Municipal Clerk designation.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a Municipality, to wit: **to provide a one-time bonus for the Oberlin Clerk of Council for achieving her Master Municipal Clerk designation on November 14, 2013, and shall take effect immediately upon passage.**


