ORDINANCE NO. 17-02 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE WELLINGTON COMMUNITY FIRE DISTRICT, SOUTH LORAIN COUNTY AMBULANCE DISTRICT, VILLAGE OF WELLINGTON, CARLISLE TOWNSHIP, CAMDEN TOWNSHIP AND ROCHESTER TOWNSHIP, DESIGNATING THE WELLINGTON COMMUNITY FIRE DISTRICT AS THE LEAD REPRESENTATIVE FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING APPLICATION FOR A LOCAL GOVERNMENT SAFETY CAPITAL GRANT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a Memo of Understanding, attached hereto, between the Village of Wellington, the Village of Rochester, Camden Township, and Carlisle Township and directed to prepare and file an application with the State of Ohio Local Government Safety Capital Grant Program (LGSCG) for the following project:

Improvement in Radio Communications

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to accept said LGSCG funding if the application is approved.

SECTION 3. That the City of Oberlin hereby agrees that if said LGSCG program is funded, the City of Oberlin will provide local matching funds as designated in the application.

SECTION 4. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


SECTION 5. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit: to approve the execution of the Memorandums of Understanding so as to facilitate the filing of an Ohio Local Government Safety Capital grant application within the time set forth in the application guidelines," and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
