ORDINANCE No. 15-01 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 111.04 (a) AND (b) OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN RELATIVE TO THE SALARY OF THE PRESIDENT, VICE-PRESIDENT AND MEMBERS OF OBERLIN CITY COUNCIL AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Sections 111.04 (a) and (b) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Oberlin, presently reading as follows:

"111.04 GENERAL PAY PROVISIONS.

- (a) Effective January 1, 2014 the salary of the President of Council shall be eight thousand four hundred dollars (\$8,400) per year, and the salary of the Vice President of Council shall be seven thousand eight hundred dollars (\$7,800) per year.
- (b) Effective January 1, 2014 the salary of all of the other members of Council shall be seven thousand two hundred dollars (\$7,200) per year."

be and hereby are, amended to read as follows:

"111.04 GENERAL PAY PROVISIONS.

- (a) Effective January 1, 2016 the salary of the President of Council shall be fourteen thousand dollars (\$14,000) per year, and the salary of the Vice President of Council shall be twelve thousand nine hundred twenty five dollars (\$12,925) per year.
- (b) Effective January 1, 2016 the salary of all of the other members of Council shall be twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000) per year."

SECTION 2. That pursuant to Section III, Paragraph E, of the Charter of the City of Oberlin, said change in salary shall be effective from and after the first Monday in January 2016.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the

citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit: to comply with the time requirements of the Charter of the City of Oberlin, and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
