ORDINANCE No. 16-10 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT STATE CAPITAL GRANT FUNDS FROM THE OHIO FACILITIES CONSTRUCTION COMMISSION AND TO SIGN A CULTURAL PROJECT COOPERATIVE USE AGREEMENT RELATED TO THE USE AND RECEIPT OF THOSE FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin desires to use the State of Ohio Capital Grant Funds which have been allocated for Phase II of the Oberlin Gasholder Building Project by the Ohio General Assembly; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin has the authority to accept financial assistance from the State of Ohio, to enter into a cooperative use agreement with the Ohio Facilities Construction Commission, and to administer funds received through the Ohio Facilities Construction Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to accept a grant award of State Capital Grant Funds in the amount of \$200,000 for the Oberlin Gasholder Building Phase II Improvement Project.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a Cultural Project Cooperative Use Agreement, attached to this ordinance as Exhibit A, with the Ohio Facilities Construction Commission for the Oberlin Gasholder Building Phase II Improvement Project.

SECTION 3. That the City of Oberlin hereby commits to provide the local share of funding as identified in the grant application.

SECTION 4. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.



That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operations of a municipal department, to wit: in order to allow for the timely execution of the construction contract for Phase II site improvements and the release of grant funds for the Gasholder project by the Ohio Facilities Construction Commission and shall take effect immediately upon passage.


