ORDINANCE NO. 07-06 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING GARY BOYLE INTERIM CITY MANAGER OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Gary Boyle be and hereby is appointed Interim City Manager of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, pursuant to Section V. c. of the Charter of the City of Oberlin, effective January 20, 2007, to serve until the position of City Manager is filled by Oberlin City Council.

\$3,850 on a bi-weekly basis. This compensation will be for the performance of all duties of the City Manager and previous duties as Planning Director of the City of Oberlin.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit:

"to immediately provide for a temporary chief executive officer of the City in order to ensure the continuous and orderly operation of the day-to-day activities of the City", and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
