

ORDINANCE NO. 07-33 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH POLEN IMPLEMENT OF ELYRIA, OHIO, THROUGH THE STATE OFFICE OF PURCHASING FOR THE PURCHASE OF A TRACTOR AND ATTACHMENTS FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 125.04 and City of Oberlin Resolution No. R88-7, the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Polen Implement, of Elyria, Ohio, through the State Office of Purchasing for the purchase of a tractor and attachments for the Public Works Department for a purchase price of \$27,872.13.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit:

"to authorize the purchase of equipment necessary for the Public Works Department as soon as possible to ensure the efficient operation of the City of Oberlin," and shall take effect immediately upon passage.

The Public Works Department seeks City Council authorization to enter into a contract with Polen Implement, Inc. of Elyria, OH for the purchase of a John Deere 1445 31hp mower and related equipment. This equipment is available through the Ohio Department of Administrative Services state purchasing program, schedule #777515E at a total cost of \$27,832.13

This purchase is the scheduled replacement of a 1994 Kubota F2100. This is the small mowing tractor which in the winter is outfitted with a broom and a blade, to remove snow from municipal sidewalks. The new John Deere tractor is proposed to be outfitted with a cab, a 72" side discharge mower, a broom and a blade. Equipment specifications are further detailed in the vendor quote attached hereto. Although the quote notes that it expires on February 27, 2007, Mr. Paschall of Polen Implement has assured me that it is still valid. The Kubota tractor is proposed to be surplused to the General Maintenance Division for use in and around the Service Complex.

This is an approved capital budget item in the 2007 budget in the amount of the quote, \$27,832. It will be paid from the Parks/Cemetery Division's allocation of the shared Equipment Reserve Fund #804 which has a current balance of approximately \$71,000.

The Public Works Department respectfully requests consideration of this item on emergency at the March 19th Council meeting. There is an estimated thirty-day delivery time which will get us to the beginning of the mowing season. If there are any questions, please let me know.
