ORDINANCE NO. 07-51 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING BELINDA ANDERSON CITY CLERK/CLERK OF OBERLIN CITY COUNCIL AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Belinda Anderson is hereby appointed City Clerk/Clerk of Oberlin City Council, effective May 28, 2007, subject to the following conditions and receiving the following benefits:

- 1. A salary of \$41,000 per annum.
- 2. All City of Oberlin full-time employee benefits, including OPERS retirement contributions, medical insurance coverage, and vacation and sick leave.
- 3. A \$150 per month vehicle expense allowance to commence when the Clerk has enrolled in an accredited course of studies leading to the designation of Certified Municipal Clerk.
- Reimbursement for fulfion, fees, and other direct expenses (other than iravei) related to the accredited course of study leading to the Certified Municipal Clerk designation, provided that the Clerk has enrolled in and remains in good standing in said course of study.
- 5. Once the Certified Municipal Clerk designation has been achieved, the salary for the position will increase by \$5,000 above its then current level.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit:

"to provide for a City Clerk/Clerk of Council for the City of Oberlin as soon as possible to ensure the efficient operation of the city", and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
