

ORDINANCE NO. 07-68

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING CERTAIN EQUIPMENT SURPLUS AND NO LONGER SUITABLE OR NECESSARY FOR ANY MUNICIPAL PURPOSE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, and the State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring

SECTION 1 That the following pieces of equipment belonging to Oberlin Municipal Light and Power System and to the City of Oberlin Public Works Department are hereby declared surplus equipment and no longer suitable or necessary for any municipal purpose, and the City Manger is hereby authorized and directed to dispose of same pursuant to the provisions of Section 121 03 of the Codified Ordinances




