ORDINANCE No. 14-24 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONTRACT WITH BELL EQUIPMENT COMPANY OF GAHANNA, OHIO, FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO (2) 2014 CRANE CARRIER CHASSIS MODEL LET2-44, EACH WITH THE 27 CUBIC YARD HEIL POWERTRAK COMMERCIAL REAR LOAD PACKER BODY FOR THE OBERLIN PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENTAND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 14-13 AC CMS, and pursuant to the authority granted under Section 9.48 of the Ohio Revised Code, the City awarded a contract to Bell Equipment Company through the National Joint Powers Alliance for the purchase of two (2) 2014 Crane Carrier Chassis Model LET2-44, each with the 27 cubic yard Heil PowerTrak Commercial Rear Load Packer Body; and

WHEREAS, during the course of placing this order, it has been discovered by the Public Works Department that the cost of each of two 2014 Crane Carrier Chassis Model LET2-44, with the 27 cubic yard Heil PowerTrak Commercial Rear Load Pacer Body is \$238,928.74 and, as a result, the contract amount needs to be increased by \$7,794.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to amend the contract with Bell Equipment Company of Gahanna, for the purchase of two (2) Crane Carrier Chassis Model LET2-44, each with the 27 Cubic Yard Heil PowerTrak Commercial Rear Load Packer Body for the purchase price each of \$238,928.74 and a combined purchase price of \$477,857.48.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit: to amend the contract price for the purchase of two (2) commercial refuse collection vehicles as soon as possible to ensure the efficient operation of the Public Works Department," and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
