ORDINANCE No. 14-41 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH TOTER INCORPORATED OF STATESVILLE, NORTH CAROLINA, THROUGH PARTICIPATION IN THE NATIONAL JOINT POWERS ALLIANCE, NJPA CONTRACT #060612-WQI FOR THE PURCHASE OF REFUSE RECYCLING COLLECTION CONTAINERS FOR THE OBERLIN PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the National Joint Powers Alliance ("NJPA"), a Minnesota political subdivision, has awarded the competitively bid public contract to Wastequip, LLC for "Solid Waste and Recycling Collection Equipment with Related Equipment, Accessories, and Supplies"; and

WHEREAS, Wastequip, LLC is the parent company for Toter Incorporated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to the authority granted under Ohio Revised Code Section 9.48, the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Toter Incorporated of Statesville, North Carolina, through participation in the National Joint Powers Alliance, ("NJPA") a Minnesota political subdivision, Contract #060612-WQI, for the purchase of refuse and recycling collection containers for the not-to-exceed purchase price of \$\$306,380.76 for the Oberlin Public Works Department.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit: to authorize the purchase of refuse and recycling collection containers as soon as possible to ensure the efficient operation of the Public Works Department, and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
