AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH QUALITY CONTROL INSPECTION, INC. (QCI) OF BEDFORD, OHIO, FOR PROFESSIONAL CONSTRUCTION ENGINEERING AND INSPECTION SERVICES FOR THE REFUSE, RECYCLING AND WASH BAY BUILDING REPLACEMENT PROJECTFOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Quality Control Inspection, Inc., of Bedford, Ohio, for professional construction engineering and inspection services for the City of Oberlin, Ohio, for the Refuse, Recycling and Wash Bay Building Replacement Project for the City of Oberlin Public Works Department in accordance with Section 2 set forth hereinafter.

SECTION 2. That the project for which said services shall be utilized, and the maximum fee to be charged is as follows:

SECTION 3. SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit: to authorize professional construction engineering and inspection services as soon as possible in order to ensure quality construction of necessary public improvements related to a City construction project about to commence", and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
