

RESOLUTION NO. R10-04 CMS

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FORMULA ALLOCATION PROGRAM FUNDING FROM THE LORAIN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS FOR THE PURPOSE OF INSTALLING A PEDESTRIAN PATH THROUGH PARK STREET PARK AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin is eligible to receive FY 2010 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds from the State of Ohio's Small Cities Formula Allocation Program; and

WHEREAS, the Lorain County Community Development Department has advised that funding is available under the FY 2010 CDBG Formula Allocation Program; and

WHEREAS, said CDBG program funds must be used for an eligible purpose including improving accessibility to and through City-owned park property.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain and State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to apply for FY 2010 CDBG Formula Allocation Program Funds to the Lorain County Board of Commissioners in the amount of \$ 22,885 for the proposed construction of an accessible pathway through Park Street Park, and that the City Manager is authorized to accept any such grant award.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


