RESOLUTION No. R14-01 CMS

A RESOLUTION SUBMITTING TO THE ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, AT THE ELECTION ON MAY 6, 2014, THE QUESTION OF PROVIDING FOR AN ADDITIONAL THREE-FIFTHS OF ONE PERCENT (3/5%) LEVY ON INCOME FOR TEN (10) YEARS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, hereby requests and directs that the Board of Elections of Lorain County, Ohio, place on the ballot at the Election to be held on May 6, 2014, the question of whether **Ordinance No. 14- 02 AC CMS**, providing for an additional three-fifths of one percent (3/5%) levy on income for the purpose of providing funds for operating and capital improvement expenses for the City of Oberlin for a period of ten (10) years, effective January 1, 2015, through December 31, 2024, be passed.

SECTION 2. That the form of the question to be placed on the ballot to be presented to the electors of the City of Oberlin shall be as follows:

**A MAJORITY AFFIRMATIVE VOTE IS NECESSARY FOR
PASSAGE**

Shall **Ordinance No. 14-02 AC CMS**, providing for an additional 3/5ths of 1% levy on income for the purpose of providing funds for operating and capital improvement expenses for the City of Oberlin for ten (10) years, effective January 1, 2015, be passed?

SECTION 3. That the Clerk of Council is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this Resolution, together with a certified copy of **Ordinance No. 14-02 AC CMS**, with the Board of Elections of Lorain County, Ohio, no later than four o'clock p.m., February 5, 2014.

SECTION 4. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.




