AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 131.01(a) OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO TO UPDATE THE OVERSIGHT RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION TO INCLUDE THE CITY OF OBERLIN STORM WATER UTILITY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of members elected thereto concurring:


SECTION 1. That Section 131.01(a) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, is hereby amended to read as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest possible date allowed by law.

131.01 ANNUAL REVIEW OF OPERATION, RATES AND FACILITIES.

(a) Commencing with the year 1973, and each year thereafter, the Public Utilities Commission shall have the responsibility and duty to review the previous annual operation of the Light and Power Department, the Water Division, the Wastewater Division and the Storm Water Utility, operated by the City. In such review, particular attention shall be given to the rate structure, income and expenses, necessary equipment, repairs and maintenance, and the Public Utilities Commission shall submit a written report to Council concerning their review and including specific recommendations on the matters reviewed. The report shall be filed by February 15, 1973, and each February 15 thereafter.
