ORDINANCE No. 18-31 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 90-14 AC CMS, ESTABLISHING AN ALLOCATION OF ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES FOR MUNICIPAL ELECTRIC, WATER, WASTEWATER, AND SOLID WASTE COLLECTION DEPARTMENTS TO ADD THE STORMWATER UTILITY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance 90-14 AC CMS, be amended as follows:


Section 1. That there is hereby established an administrative charge of 5% of the gross revenues of the prior year of each of the municipal electric, water, wastewater, and solid waste collection departments and of the stormwater utility, said charge to be allocated to the general fund of the City of Oberlin and to cover legislative, legal, general administrative and public safety services furnished to each of said departments.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect at the earliest possible date allowed by law.
