ORDINANCE No. 18-49 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING PART-TIME POLICE OFFICERS TO BE PART OF THE UNCLASSIFIED SERVICE OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Section XIX(G)(6) of the Oberlin City Charter authorizes Oberlin City Council to designate by ordinance part-time firefighters and part-time police officers as being part of the unclassified service; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department will remain competitive through the enhancement of its recruitment and hiring process; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain and State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That part-time police officers are hereby designated to be part of the Unclassified Service of the City of Oberlin.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department to wit: to enhance the City's ability to compete for qualified and talented candidates for part-time police officer positions without delay and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
