ORDINANCE NO. 19-40 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 19-25 AC CMS TO REVISE THE LOCAL MATCHING FUNDS AMOUNT FROM \$86,595 TO \$125,065 FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROJECT FOR SPRING STREET PARK AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Lorain County Commissioners receive a biennial allocation of Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG) funds from the State of Ohio which can be used for eligible projects in non-entitlement areas within Lorain County; and,

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 19-25, Council authorized the City Manager to apply for CDBG funding up to \$100,000 for the Spring Street Improvement Project, ("Project") and committed to \$86,595 in matching funds if the application was approved; and,

WHEREAS, the City was notified by the Lorain County Commissioners that the County intends to award the \$61,530 in Community Development Block Grant funds for the Project; and,

WHEREAS, because the CDBG funding awarded by the Lorain County Commissioners is less than the \$100.000 requested by the City, the amount of local matching funds must be increased by \$38,650 to cover the entire cost of the Project; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 19-25 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"That if the application for funding is approved, the City of Oberlin, Ohio will commit general revenue funds as matching funds in the amount of \$125,065."

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department to wit: to approve an increase in local matching funds so that a funding commitment letter can be sent to Lorain County and the State of Ohio Development Services Agency as soon as possible as the grant application deadline was June 14, 2019, and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
