- A Council subcommittee is reviewing applications for boards and commissions. Thank you to all who applied!
- The City is exploring relief funding to further assist local non-profits.
- Annual budget sessions are scheduled for Nov. 23 (1:30 - 5:30) and 24 (1:30 - 6:30.)
- An aforementioned anti-discrimination ordinance is expected the first meeting in December.
- New equipment for Spring Street Park is expected to arrive in December.
- IGA underwent a food waste audit, and additional audits are expected for data collection regarding a potential composting program.
- The results of a traffic signal study conducted last year are in, and several ADA-related improvements are recommended.
