- The Recreation Department is on track to allow the use of the Hamilton Recreation Complex for organized sports in 2021. Health and safety measures will be in place regarding Covid-19 and are subject to change.
- The City's Climate Action Plan Working Group heard a presentation from Oberlin College about its sustainable infrastructure thermal heating project. Construction begins in May by a company chosen for their record with minority and/or disadvantaged businesses.
- Reports from the food waste project show that if we increased our recovery/compost to 25% we could save 54 metric tons of CO2e per year.
