RESOLUTION No. R21-03 CMS

A RESOLUTION RESCINDING RESOLUTIONS R00-04 CMS AND R04-12 CMS RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT AND SUPPLEMENT TO A POLICY AND PROCEDURE RELATING TO THE BUDGETARY AMOUNT THAT MAY BE MADE AVAILABLE EACH YEAR BY OBERLIN CITY COUNCIL IN ORDER TO FUND CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENTS FOR SERVICES TO BE RENDERED TO THE CITY BY VARIOUS COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS

WHEREAS, By Resolution R00-04 CMS Council established the policy and procedure to budget for and process requests for contractual agreements with community organizations on February 7, 2000. By Resolution No. R04-12 CMS, Council subsequently supplemented the original resolution on January 3, 2005 to add a philosophy statement and establish a tiering system; and

WHEREAS, Council established a subcommittee to evaluate the Community Organization funding policy and procedure. The subcommittee has completed its work and is recommending that City Council rescind R00-04 CMS and R04-12 CMS and transition the process from City Council to the City Manager to administer the contracts, in a similar manner as other City contracts for services; and

WHEREAS, Council does not intend to stop funding for community organization contracts, but only to transition the administration of Community Organization service contracts from Council to the City Manager. Council will still retain budgetary authority to appropriate funds for such contracts on an annual basis.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Resolutions R00-04 CMS and R04-12 CMS are hereby rescinded.

SECTION 2. That Community Organization funding shall be managed by the City Manager in the same manner as other City of Oberlin contracts for services.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.


