## ORDINANCE No. 21-40 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH BARNES NURSERY INC. OF HURON OHIO TO PROVIDE FOOD COMPOSTING SERVICES FOR THE CITIZENS OF OBERLIN AND AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FROM THE SUSTAINABLE RESERVE FUND TO PAY FOR THOSE SERVICES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, and State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an Agreement with Barnes Nursery Inc., in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit A and authorizing the expenditure of up to Three Hundred and Twenty-Five Thousand, One Hundred and Thirty Dollars (\$325,130) from the Sustainable Reserve Fund to be paid over a five-year term pursuant to the terms of said Agreement.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance shall take effect on the earliest date permitted by law.
