ORDINANCE No. 21-58 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH JACK DOHENY COMPANIES, INC., OF NORTHVILLE, MICHIGAN, THROUGH THE STATE OFFICE OF PURCHASING FOR THE PURCHASE OF A VACTOR 2110-i COMBINATION SEWER CLEANER MOUNTED ON A FREIGHTLINER 114 SD CHASSIS FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT AS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 125.04 and City of Oberlin Resolution No. R88-7, the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Jack Doheny Companies, Inc. of Northville, Michigan, for the purchase of a Vactor 2110-i Combination Sewer Cleaner mounted on a Freightliner 114 SD Chassis for the City of Oberlin Public Works Department for the purchase price of \$297,130.82.

SECTION 2. In accordance with City of Oberlin Codified Ordinance Chapter 121.03 (c)4 – Disposition of Surplus Municipal Personal Property, the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to trade in a 2017 Vactor Ramjet mounted on a Freightliner 114 SD Chassis from the City of Oberlin Public Works Department to Jack Doheny Companies, Inc. for the surplus price of \$135,000.00.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit: **to authorize the purchase of the Vactor 2110-i Combination Sewer Cleaner mounted on a Freightliner 114 SD Chassis as soon as possible to ensure the efficient operation of the Public Works Department**, and provided that it is elevated to emergency status by the affirmative vote of at least five members of Council and receives the affirmative vote of at least five members of Council upon final passage, it shall go into full force and effect from and immediately after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
