ORDINANCE No. 21-61 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 21-03 AC CMS AUTHORIZING THE CITY LAW DIRECTOR TO INSTITUTE PROCEEDINGS FOR THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE CITY OF OBERLIN LOCATED IN NEW RUSSIA TOWNSHIP AND DIRECTING THE LAW DIRECTOR TO WITHDRAW SAID PROCEEDINGS

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 21-03 AC CMS authorized and directed the City Law Director to prepare, file and prosecute to conclusion an annexation petition for certain real property owned by the City, located in New Russia Township and more particularly described therein; and

WHEREAS, on June 8, 2021, the City Law Director filed a petition for said annexation with the Board of Lorain County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to repeal Ordinance No. 21-03 AC CMS and to authorize and direct the Law Director to withdraw the petition.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain and State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1: That Ordinance No. 21-03 AC CMS be and is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2: That the City Law Director is hereby authorized and directed to withdraw the annexation petition filed pursuant to the authority conferred by Ordinance No. 21-03 CMS.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal action of this Council concerning or related to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: That this Ordinance shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
