ORDINANCE No. 21-62 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING NEW SECTION 109 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN TO PROVIDE FOR THE DESIGNATION OF THE USE OF SPACES WITHIN BULDING FACILITIES OWNED BY THE CITY OF OBERLIN

WHEREAS, Council desires to adopt provisions for the assignment of certain spaces and for the lease and use of buildings and properties owned by the City of Oberlin.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That Section 109, of the Codified Ordnances of the City of Oberlin, "Use of Building Facilities," is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§ 109.1 Designation of City Office Spaces:

Council shall, by resolution, provide for the future assignment of spaces in the City Hall and other buildings owned by the City for its own use and for the use and occupancy of Council appointees and their staff. All other spaces, except those of the Oberlin Municipal Court, may be assigned by the City Manager for the use and occupancy of the various departments under the City Manager's official charge.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall go into effect on the earliest date permitted by law.
