AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 351.15 OF THE OBERLIN CODIFIED ORDINANCES PROHIBITING PARKING OF VEHICLES IN CITY STREETS AND ALLEYS IN RESIDENTIAL DISTRICTS BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 2:00 AM AND 6:00 AM

WHEREAS, Section 351.15 of the Oberlin Codified Ordinances prohibits the parking of vehicles in residential districts between the hours of 2:00 AM and 6:00 AM from November 1st and April 1st of each year; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to repeal Ordinance No. 351.15.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain and State of Ohio:

<u>SECTION 1:</u> That Council finds and determines that the prohibition contained in Ordinance No. 351.15 is unnecessary and does not serve a significant public purpose.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: That Section 351.15 of the Oberlin Codified Ordinances be and is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal action of this Council concerning or related to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: That this Ordinance shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
