**RESOLUTION No. R22-01 CMS**

**A RESOLUTION APPOINTING EBONI JOHNSON AS THE DESIGNEE OF THE MEMBERS OF COUNCIL FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE PUBLIC RECORDS LAW AS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE**

WHEREAS, Ohio Law requires elected officials to undergo educational training for every term of office related to the requirements of the public records law, Ohio Revised Code Section 149.43; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 109.43 provides that the elected officials of a public office may appoint a “Designee” to undergo such training on their behalf; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that Eboni Johnson, Council Member of Oberlin City Council should serve as the legal “Designee” of the members of Council.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Eboni Johnson is hereby appointed the “Designee” within the meaning set forth in Ohio Revised Code Section 109.43

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


SECTION 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, to wit: **to ensure timely appointment of a designee for members of Council to meet the January 26, 2022 deadline for Ohio Sunshine Law Certification Training** and provided that it is elevated to emergency status by the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members of council and receives the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members of council upon final passage, it shall go into full force and effect from and immediately after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
