ORDINANCE No. 22-07 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH MUNICIPAL EMERGENCY SERVICES, INC., OF WARREN, OHIO, THROUGH SOURCEWELL, FOR THE PURCHASE OF HURST EDRAULIC EXTRICATION TOOLS AND ACCESSORY EQUIPMENT FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN FIRE DEPARTMENT AS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio,:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to the authority granted under Section 9.48 of the Ohio Revised Code , the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Municipal Emergency Services of Warren, Ohio, through Sourcewell, RFP 040220, for the purchase of one (1) S 378 E3 Hurst Cutter, one (1) SP 555 E3 Hurst Spreader, one (1) R 521 E3 Hurst Ram, and four (4) StrongArm Fire 100E Combination Tool Packages for a total cost of \$50,900.02 including shipping.


SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit: to authorize the purchase of equipment as soon as possible to ensure the efficient operation of the Fire Department, and shall take effect immediately upon passage. and provided that it is elevated to emergency status by the affirmative vote of at least five members of Council and receives the affirmative vote of at least five members of Council upon final passage, it shall go into full force and effect from and immediately after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
