ORDINANCE No. 22-12 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSENT TO AN ASSIGNMENT OF A CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF OBERLIN AND ADVANCED COMPUTER CONNECTIONS LLC TO ES CONSULTING INC. AS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 19-74 AC CMS, effective December 2, 2019, the Council of City of Oberlin authorized and directed the City Manager to enter into a Managed Services Agreement with Advanced Computer Connections LLC. of Norwalk, Ohio (“ACC”) to provide computer maintenance and information system services to the City of Oberlin; and

WHEREAS, effective December 10, 2021, ACC was acquired by ES Consulting, Inc., (“ES”); and

WHEREAS, as part the ES acquisition of ACC, the parties entered into an agreement for the Assignment and Assumption of ACC contract. A copy of said agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

WHEREAS, it is necessary that City of Oberlin consent to the assignment of the ACC contract to ES to enable continued computer maintenance and information services support to the City.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute a consent to an assignment of the contract between the City of Oberlin and ACC to ES in a form to be prepared by the Law Director.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the usual daily operations of the City departments, to wit: to enable continued computer maintenance and information systems support to the city and provided that it is elevated to emergency status by the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members of council and receives the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members of council upon final passage, it shall go into full

force and effect from and immediately after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
