ORDINANCE No. 22-24 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING THE CITY OF OBERLIN REPRESENTATIVE AND ALTERNATE TO REPRESENT THE MEMBER, THE CITY OF OBERLIN, WITH THE PUBLIC ENTITIES POOL OF OHIO FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN AS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin has been a Member of the Public Entities Pool of Ohio (the "Pool") since 1988 and the membership agreement automatically renews each year unless the City elects to withdraw from the Pool; and

WHEREAS, from time to time, it is necessary for each Member of the Pool to designate a representative and alternate to represent the Member with the Pool in accordance with the Intergovernmental Contract.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio:


SECTION 1. Pursuant to Article IV of the Public Entities Pool of Ohio Intergovernmental Contract, the Council of the City of Oberlin, the Pool Member, designates the City Finance Director as representative and Finance Assistant, designated by the City Finance Director, as alternate to represent the City of Oberlin with the Pool. The representative or alternate, consistent with the Intergovernmental Contract, shall cast any votes required by Members. The representative or alternate shall also act as liaison between the Member and the Pool, for purposes of relaying risk reduction and loss control information, and any other information or instructions provided by the Pool to Members. Further, it is agreed that the representative or alternate shall receive any rules or regulations of the Pool.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit: to timely designate the City of Oberlin's representative and alternate with the Public Entities Pool of Ohio in accordance with the Intergovernmental Contract, and provided that it is elevated to emergency status by the affirmative vote of at least five members of Council and receives the affirmative vote of at least five members of Council upon final passage, it shall go into full force and effect from and immediately after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
