## ORDINANCE No. 22- 70 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONTRACT WITH ATLANTIC EMERGENCY SOLUTIONS, INC OF MANASSAS, VIRGINIA, FOR THE PURCHASE OF A 2022 PIERCE VELOCITY 100 FOOT REAR-MOUNTED AERIAL PLATFORM FOR THE OBERLIN FIRE DEPARTMENT AS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 21-36 AC CMS, the City awarded a contract to Atlantic Emergency Solutions, Inc. through the State Office of Purchasing for the purchase of a 2022 Pierce Velocity Rear-Mounted Aerial Platform; and

WHEREAS, during the course of placing this order, it has been discovered by the Oberlin Fire Department that the cost of the Pierce Velocity Rear-Mounted Aerial Platform is \$1,512,053.26 and, as a result, the contract amount needs to be increased by an additional amount not to exceed \$18,619.26.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to do all things necessary or convenient to amend the contract with Atlantic Emergency Solutions, of Manassas, Virginia for the purchase of a 2022 Pierce Velocity 100-foot rear-mounted aerial platform to increase the purchase price by an amount not to exceed \$18,619.26 for a total purchase price not to exceed \$1,512,053.26.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal, department, to wit: to amend the contract price for the purchase of a 2022 Pierce Velocity 100 foot rear-mounted aerial platform as soon as possible to ensure the efficient operation of the Oberlin Fire Department, and shall take effect immediately upon passage provided that it is elevated to emergency status by the affirmative vote of at least five members of Council and receives the affirmative vote of at least five members of Council upon final passage, it shall go into full force and effect from and immediately after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
