ORDINANCE No. 23-01 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONTRACT WITH PFUND SUPERIOR SALES CO., INC. OF LOWER BURREL, PENNSYLVANIA FOR THE PURCHASE OF A 2022 FREIGHTLINER LIFE LINE TYPE I AMBULANCE, MODEL HIGHLINER FOR THE OBERLIN FIRE DEPARTMENT AS EMERGENCY MEASURE

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 21-24 AC CMS, and pursuant to the authority granted under Section 9.48 of the Ohio Revised Code, the City awarded a contract to Pfund Superior Sales Co. Inc. through the State Office of Purchasing for the purchase of a 2022 Freightliner Life Line Type I Ambulance, Model “Highliner”; and

WHEREAS, during the course of placing this order, it has been discovered by the Oberlin Fire Department that the cost of the Freightliner Life Line Type I Ambulance is \$415,263.68 and, as a result, the contract amount needs to be increased by \$2,127.00

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to amend the contract with Pfund Superior Sales Co. Inc. of Lower Burrel, Pennsylvania for the purchase of a 2022 Freightliner Life Line Type I Ambulance not to exceed the final purchase price of \$415,263.68.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, or to provide for the usual daily operation of a municipal department, to wit: to amend the contract price for the purchase of a 2022 Freightliner Life Line Type I Ambulance as soon as possible to ensure the efficient operation of the Oberlin Fire Department, and provided it is elevated to emergency status by the affirmative vote of at least five members of Council and receives the affirmative vote of at least five members of Council upon final passage, it shall go into full force and effect from and immediately after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect on the earliest date allowed by law.
